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Subject : Pre. Ph.D. Theory Course work Procedure for Calculation of CGPA as per 10 Point Scale.

9.1.9 Calculation of CGPA and Grades for Pre Ph.D. theory Course work Pre Ph.D. theory course is of total three courses as follows:

Table 1: Course wise allotted credits

Course No.	Course Name	Credits (c)
PP-01	Research Methodology & Research Publication Ethics	4
PP-02	Subject specific course	4
PP-03	Research area-based course	4

The grade points shall be awarded as per the 10-point scale, as given in Table 2 below:

- The grade points will be awarded on the total marks obtained in each course.
- The **total grade points earned in each course** shall be calculated as –
= Grade points obtained (vide Table-2) X Credits for the course
= (g X c)

Table 2: Marks to Grade and Grade Point conversion for each course

Obtained Grade/ Grade Description	Grade Point (g)
O: Outstanding	10
A+: Excellent	9
A: Very Good	8
B+ Good	7
B: Above Average	6
C: Average	5
P: Pass	4
F: Fail	0

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- Research Scholar who fails to secure 40% marks, in any of the courses or all the three courses, shall not be considered for CGPA calculation.
- Overall performance in the Pre Ph.D. theory course work, after successful completion of all the 03 courses will be calculated as per the CGPA formula given below and the performance of the research scholar will be declared by an equivalent grade given in Table 3.

The formula is as given below:

$$CGPA = \frac{\sum_{i=1}^3 (c_i * g_i)}{\sum_{i=1}^3 (c_i)}$$

where,


g_i = grade point obtained in course i

c_i = credit allotted for course i

Table 3: Final Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA)

07.00-07.99	A+
06.00-06.99	A
05.50-05.99	B+
05.00-05.49	B
04.50-04.99	C
04.00-04.49	P
00.00-03.99	F

- The research scholars who fail to secure 40 marks separately in individual course or who fail to obtain **B grade** (minimum CGPA 5.0, for Reserved category) or **B+ grade** (minimum CGPA 5.5, for Open category) as per Table 3, shall have to obtain minimum 40 marks in each course and CGPA B/B+, as the case may be, in the next two attempts.
- The result of Pre Ph.D. theory course work shall be declared in letter grade as per CGPA range shown in Table 3.
