



Notification regarding online Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course Work Examination (2025)

The Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University is conducting Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course Work Examination for those students who have completed course work.

A. The date of Examination is - 18/12/2025 .

Detailed time schedule along with subject, batch, time slot will be published on university website.

The syllabi for Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course is available on university website.

B. There shall be two Papers

Paper 1- (PHD 001) : Research Methodology, Research and Publication Ethics (RM-RPE) and

Paper 2 – (PHD 002) : Subject Specific Course

- Both the Papers i.e. Paper-I and Paper-II will consist of only objective type questions.
 - Question paper shall consists of 50 questions. All Questions are Compulsory.
 - Duration of Examination is 1 hour for each paper in ONE session.
 - There will be no negative marking.
 - Questions and Multiple-Choice Answers will be in both languages i.e. English and Marathi (wherever is necessary.)
 - The Sample question Bank is available on university Website.
- C. The Examination of Pre-Ph.D. Theory Course Paper-I and Paper-II will be conducted at **Online Examination Center, School of Mathematical Sciences Building(New), Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon** through Computer Based Exam.
- D. Candidates who will appear only for Paper I / Paper II/Both Paper I and Paper II, accordingly, links shall be provided for the examination.
- E. Hall ticket with Username and Password for exam shall be made available in the candidate's Ph.D. Process login.
- F. All the necessary instructions regarding the exam shall be printed on the Hall Ticket.
- G. Standard of passing and grades for Pre-Ph.D. course work shall be as per circular number 58/2024 (Ref. No. :- KBCNMU/11/Ph.D./Rules/1457/2024) dated 09/11/2024.
- H. Candidates shall be declared qualified only when they have score minimum passing marks (40) individually in each paper and when they score overall minimum grade 'B' (CGPA 5.00-5.49 for reserved category students) or Grade 'B+' (CGPA 5.50-5.99 for Open category students)
- I. Result shall be made available to the candidate in his/her login within 7 days after examination.

- J. The Result /Score obtained by the candidate in each Paper having grade below B+ (CGPA) for Open Category and B grade for reserved category/differently abled persons shall not be considered to continue Ph.D. programme in PET-2024 process until he/she qualifies in Paper I and II or both.(as the case may be in the next two attempts.)
- K. No query shall be entertained regarding score/grade, after the Result declaration .
- L. Paper 3- (PHD 003) : Guide's Course Based on Research Area : **(Total Marks 100)**
- 1.A Review Article of 20 Marks.**
- 2. Two seminar of 40 Marks each.**
- The evaluation of the Seminar components will be based on following four sub-heads.

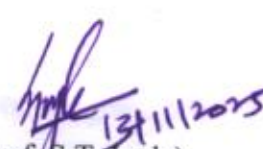

The reports of seminars and review article along with a copy of Paper-III mark shall kept to his College/Institute custody and make available as and when university will ask(Need not to send University)

- M. **For Visually Handicapped (VH)** candidates thirty minutes extra time shall be provided separately for Paper-I and Paper – II. They will also be provided with the services of scribe who would be a graduate in a subject other than that of the candidate. Those Physically Handicapped (PH) candidates who are not in a position to write in their own hand-writing can also avail these services by making prior request (at least one week before the date of Pre-Ph.D. Theory Examination) in writing one the Pro-Vice Chancellor. Extra time and facility of scribe would not be provided to other Physically handicapped candidates.
